



Call for Abstracts for the 13th Annual Duke Center for AIDS Research (CFAR) Fall Scientific Retreat

PLACE: Trent Semans Center, Great Hall and 6th Floor (poster presentations)

DATE: Monday, September 18, 2017; 8AM – 4PM

All pre- and post-doctoral trainees, as well as junior faculty investigators conducting AIDS-related research at Duke are encouraged to submit a **one-page abstract** for poster presentation at the thirteenth annual CFAR Fall Scientific Retreat.

This is an opportunity to share your research design, progress, and new insights with others in the Duke University community. Final results are not required, and ‘works in progress’ and posters that have been recently presented at other meetings are welcome.

Each investigator submitting an abstract will be expected to give a poster presentation, and three abstracts will be selected for oral presentation. Prizes will be awarded for all oral presenters, and the top poster presentation in each of these categories: Basic Research, Clinical Research, and Social and Behavioral Research. Oral presenters are not required to present posters.

Abstract Format:

- Include your name, email, job title, department affiliation, mentor (if applicable), and research category (Basic, Clinical, SBS).
- Abstract should be no longer than one page. (Above information is not included in page limit.)
- PDF Format
- File name convention “LastName.FirstName.CFAR2017FR.pdf”
- *Name on file will be considered/contacted for poster/oral presentation*

Posters:

Posters may be set up beginning at 7:30AM on the day of the Retreat, and must be in place on the 6th Floor of Trent Semans by 8:30AM. They should remain on display until the conclusion of the Retreat at 4:00PM.

There is no size restriction on posters, but please let us know if your poster will be larger than 48” wide.
